



Health and Safety Guidelines for the 2020-2021 School Year

These policies are based on what is currently known about the transmission and severity of COVID-19 and is updated as needed and as additional information becomes available.

What your Child May Bring to School

- Labeled book bag or diaper bag, sippy cup or water bottle
- Labeled lunch box (containers within the lunchbox needs to be labeled)
- Children are welcome to wear mask. Teachers will do their best to help encourage them to wear them throughout the day.

Children may not bring toys, “lovies”, blankets or stuffed animals from home

Arrival to Preschool

- Parents will drop off children through morning car line
- Children’s temperatures will be scanned before leaving their vehicle
- Limits on individuals entering the building
- Teachers will wash hands once children arrive in their classrooms

The Preschool Day

- Proper handwashing will continue throughout the preschool day
- Touchless faucets and soap dispensers have been added to each classroom
- Classroom will have music and recess; times will be staggered for cleaning each area. Teachers and children will stay with their individual classroom
- Supplies will be cleaned after an activity
- Toys used during the day will be placed outside the classroom to be cleaned. Depending on the material that makes up the toy or manipulatives used the items will be cleaned using the industrial dishwasher or spraying and hand cleaning the toy daily
- High touch areas will be cleaned throughout the day
- Rooms will be cleaned each afternoon with an electrostatic sprayer
